The goal of this course is to have students work on the most challenging part of AP US History (APUSH), i.e. Short Response and Long Essay and Document based questions. The instructor will focus on "Templates" which ease the burden of figuring out how to write an introduction or conclusion. The Template will include various methods to begin any Long Essay or Document based question. Besides helping with the writing component the course will also provide various AP Trigger periods that are relevant to the thematic essay. In addition each week essays will be assigned and graded by an AP certified instructor for both courses.
