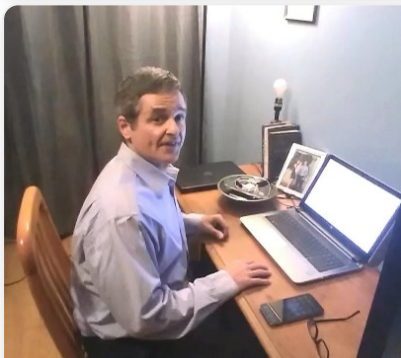
Course Instructors
